**Description of application**

This is a so-called Chemise of the Virgin Mary, which has stood in front of Aachen Cathedral since 19 June 2014. It was built for the pilgrims who have been coming here for more than 660 years. The aim of this pilgrimage is the adoration of four relics (ancient fabrics) that have been kept as a treasure at Aachen Cathedral since the times of Charlemagne. Every seven years, these relics are shown to the faithful from all over the world. The Chemise of the Virgin, which has a total height of 2,800 x 1,700mm, was completely hand-crafted by cutting to size different sheets, which were subsequently cold-curved, milled, polished and bonded.

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
